Community Yard Sale on October 14 was very successful once again. I am grateful for all who volunteered before, during and after the sale. Total proceeds as of today is \$2162.11. More money continues to come in during post sale purchases. God has blessed with the ability to share donated items at affordable prices that our community neighbors can buy and enjoy. We are grateful for our volunteers from the University of Memphis, Dr. Candace Walsh and her student Justin Plummer. We hope to maintain and expand that relationship to build our pool of volunteers for future sales.

Yard Sale on our property on October 21, championed by Beth Baker and her volunteers, raised \$2650 for the Lisieux Community, whose mission "is to support and educate women who have survived trauma, addiction, prostitution, and life on the streets". 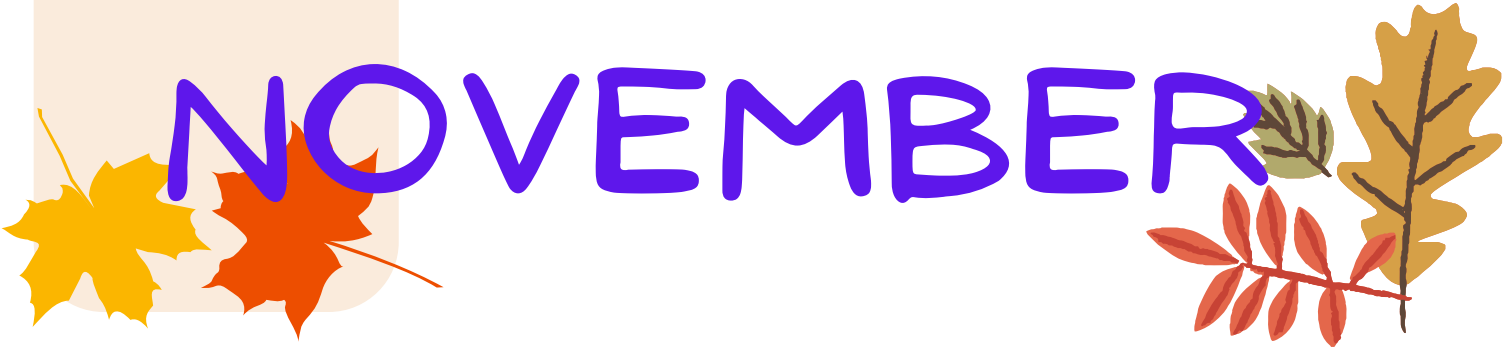
